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I awoke to hear Adorable BB of the silvery tongue (but not latterly of the silvery tankard) say 'thank you' for volunteering to write up the trail, was it trickery, auto-suggestion or hypnosis. Before I could say no, he was off onto another subject; too late I tried to protest & failed miserably.

Anyway about 8 hashers met at Lumpini for the shared lifts to the RV (which was at Srinakarin Road, Soi 53), and as there were 3 car drivers they all divided up into their chosen chariots. All 3 cars set off together but they each seemed to go their own way. Shaggy (Tony) despite appearing slightly lost (his loan car had no GPS), with several u-turns arrived first, followed by Adorable & co. The third car arrived about 30 mins later, perhaps they stopped off for a beer en route? Gradually hashers appeared as if by some pre-ordained master plan. The drink drive truck arrived with the newly pledged and there was plenty of time for socialising, pleasantries, un-pleasantries, limbering up, posing around or general chatting.

Eventually a circle of about 26 hashers was called & Coconut Kernel the hare (the co-hare was later found to be Sugar Daddy) explained his trail brief. Then we were off, some loping, others limping, some lagging behind. We went back along Soi 53 the runners passing some walkers (including Cengiz) onto Srinakarin Road turned right inhaling the early afternoon fumes. Some way along the road the trail went down a small Soi which opened up to a small golf training range/school where after a brief wander we found the way in the far corner where the path then became a klong-way on the left of the water. The trail then appeared to go left into a scenic wooded rubbish dump, with large puddles & muddy areas where Shaggy & Diarrhoea found a large chalky check. But they had been fooled, as the trail was just straight down the concrete raised path. 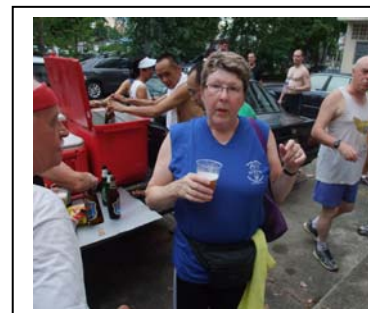
