Secret Scribe Report ... (Onsec Note – 26 total including 2 hares, 12 men with members, 7 women without members, 0 new boots, and 5 visitors showed up!) Now for this week's prose:

Misdirections (via Phra Nank Klao bridge)

Take the some-stage expressway in the direction of Chaeng Wattana and exit shortly after the 10 Baht toll booth to Ngam Wong Wan rd going left (eastwards). Follow direction 302 Bang Bua Thong / Suphan Buri and go over the Phra Nang Klao Bridge (Hash bridge).

After the bridge keep to the left and follow the direction Chaiyapreuk (or Chaiya Phruk) which will put you via a fly-over on Ratchapreuk road going north. Once on Ratchapreuk take the first u-turn (keep left) after about 1.5K going underneath Ratchapreuk. About 350 meters after making the u-turn turn left (going underneath an golden arch).

Follow this winding road for 1.5K (after the first 350m follow the road to right after another 200m to the left) and turn left at the t-junction. After about another 1.1K turn right. On this road: 1.) after 0.5K at the Y-junction keep right, 2.) after 850m follow the road to the left and 3.) after 1.1K turn right (sign Tha It Suksa school in front of you). Follow this road for 200m till you see an open field on your left. The run is expected to start from here (HHH sign).

If you would come from the south on Ratchapreuk from any of the other bridges, then take the first u-turn after crossing Rattana Thibet road; see above for the rest.

If you would come from Chaeng Wattana road then cross Rama IV bridge onto Chaiyapreuk and go south on



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toes wet; surely the Hare would not take us there he said....?! The tried to go around it, they tried left, the broke the farmers gate to go right. FINALLY we all had to go through it. Shiggy and water up to thigh deep in places and lots of long, tall grass. WHERE was Snake when you need her to scream at the top of her lungs (ostensibly) to scare away the thundering hordes of snakes that evidently reside in the tall grass????
